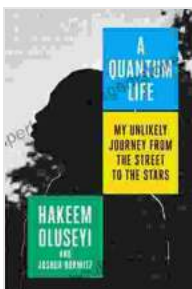


# My Unlikely Journey From the Street To the Stars: A Memoir of Perseverance, Hope, and Redemption
